



A restrictor is available to correct hard starting and excessive smoking when starting a warm engine and bogging on acceleration on the models listed. The restrictor is brass and has a 0.031 inch (0.8 mm) hole in the center. Insert one restrictor (either way) in the outlet end of each bleed line (next to the fitting on the transfer port) going to the transfer port. The number of bleed lines varies with each engine.






b - 1/2 inch (13 mm)
