Carburetor Vent Hose - 25 Four Stroke



Situation

In certain situations, a small amount of fuel may exit from the carburetor float bowl vent hose when the outboard is fully tilted and turned on the starboard side. The cause may be that the carburetor vent hose has moved downward and is now out of position.



a - Carburetor Float Bowl Vent Hose



Correction

REPOSITION THE VENT HOSE AND RETAIN WITH STA-STRAP

Check that the vent hose is routed high and back against the electro thermo valve. If not, move the vent hose up towards the carburetor electro thermo valve. Use a 54-816311 sta-strap to secure the vent hose as high as possible and against the electro thermo valve. Outboards starting with USA serial number 0T614774 & Belgium serial number 0P210463 have the sta-strap installed. The outlet of the vent hose should remain in the hole in the adaptor plate flange.

VENT HOSE MODIFICATION

Boats with very steep transoms that allow the outboard to be tilted further forward may re-quire a slight modification to the existing carburetor float bowl vent hose.

EXTEND VENT HOSE END

Carefully pull the outlet end of the vent hose out of the hole in the adaptor plate flange. Re-move and discard the sta-strap and the 89 mm (3-1/2 in.) long hose extension from the end of the vent hose coupler. Cut a new 120 mm (4-3/4 in.) length of 32-856822-39 large hose. Install the new piece of hose on the connector and secure with a sta-strap 54-816311.




MODIFY VENT HOSE ATTACHED TO BRASS FITTING

Remove the sta-strap and the vent hose from the starboard carburetor brass vent fitting. Reroute the vent hose behind the electro thermo valve. Cut 15 mm (0.59 or 19/32 in.) off the end of the existing vent hose that was connected to the carburetor brass vent fitting and discard. Cut a new 40 mm (1-9/16 in.) length of 32-99126-88 small hose. Connect the short-ened vent hose and the new small hose with a 22-822771 barbed fitting. Lubrication of the barbed fitting and the hose may be necessary for ease of assembly.



REASSEMBLY


Assemble the new hose end to the carburetor brass vent fitting and install sta-strap 69355 in the three locations.
