## A. CARBURETOR TO MANIFOLD MOUNTING GASKET - ALL MERCUISER ENGINES

The carburetor to manifold mounting gasket that comes in all carburetor repair, gasket, or overhaul kits for the above model engines **MUST NOT BE USED**. The mounting gasket contained in these service kits are used in automotive applications **NOT** marine applications. Future service kits will have this automotive mounting gasket eliminated. Order the correct mounting gasket from the engine parts lists.

## B. FUEL INLET FILTER GASKET - ROCHESTER 2BBL AND 4BBL CARBURETORS

When replacing the fuel inlet filter (35-53336) in the above model carburetors, the fuel inlet gasket should also be replaced. This gasket is not with the fuel filter. The part number is listed below.

## C. NEW??? MERCURY PART NUMBERS

Several years ago, an entire block of 5000 part numbers (Part No. 40000 thru 45000) was set aside for use on a special project. For some reason, only a few of these numbers were assigned to a given part. These numbers are now being assigned to **NEW** parts (also with prefixes and/or suffixes). When you see these part numbers, don't be misled . . . it may be an "old" part number but, it will probably be a "new" part.

## D. PORTABLE TIMING LIGHT (Part No. 91-99379)

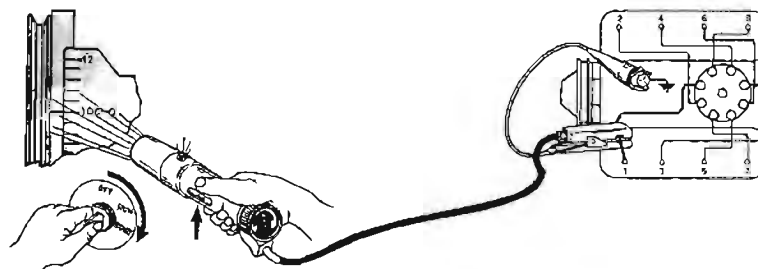

## E. QUICKSILVER VOLT/OHM METER (91-93572)

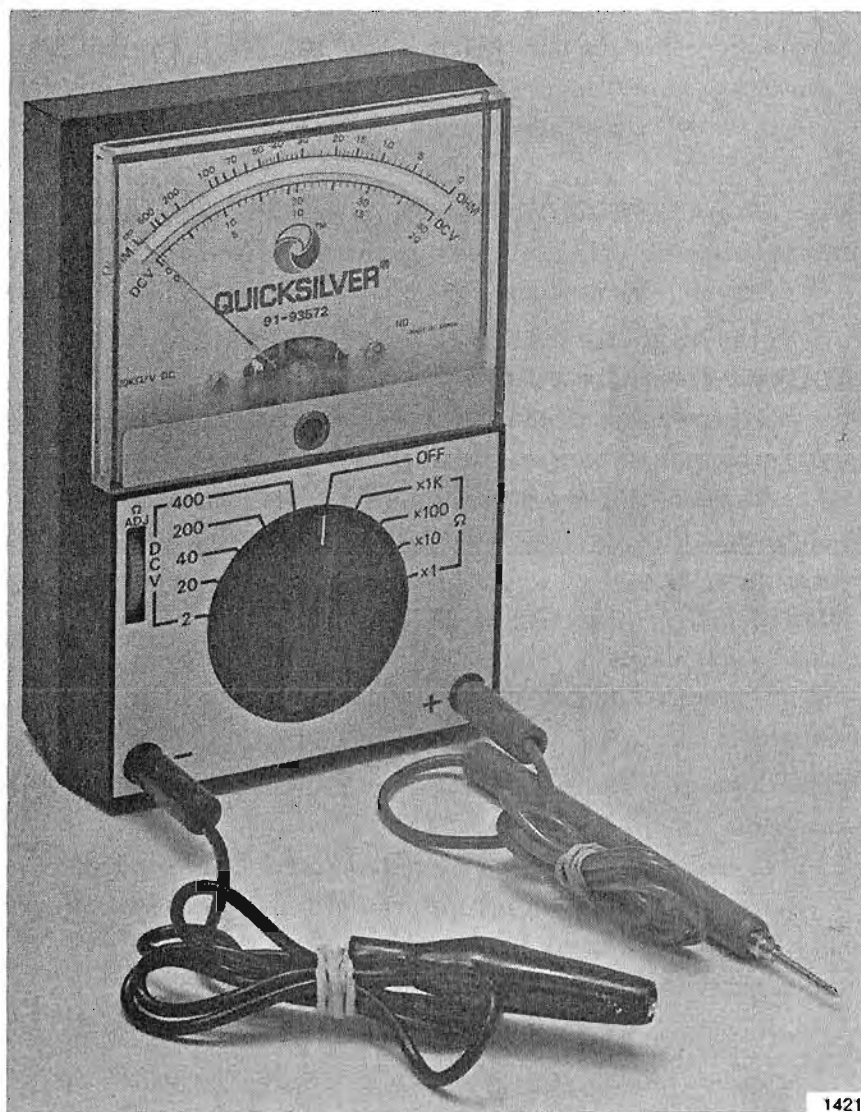
A Quicksilver Volt/Ohm Meter (91-93572) now is available for electrical/ignition system testing. This versatile meter is capable of performing all required measurements [Resistance (Ohms -  $\Omega$ ) and Direct Current Voltage (DCV)] for proper electrical/ignition system testing of Mercury - MerCruiser - Mariner products.

*NOTE: Quicksilver Volt/Ohm Meter 91-93572 SUPERSEDES Quicksilver VOA Meter 91-62562A1 (VOA Meter from Quicksilver Thunderbolt Ignition Analyzer).*

The meter can also be used with Reference Electrode Assembly, 76675A1, (to check galvanic corrosion potential), provided the original "jack" on the Reference Electrode Assembly [which contains a resistor for proper scale reading when used with Quicksilver VOA Meter 91-62562A1]) is replaced with a standard "jack" (available from local electronic stores).
