## Vent Valve Water Leak



#### Scope

#### Situation

Mercury MerCruiser has observed vent valves leaking water. This is due to a crack in the valve housing in three possible locations.




a - Crack locations

#### Correction

Inspect the vent valves on both of the elbows during predelivery inspection (PDI) or when servicing 8.2 ECT sterndrive and inboard engines within the specified serial number range. If the vent valve is cracked or leaking, replace the vent valve hose assembly.

- 1. Loosen the hose clamps at the elbow and poppet valve.
- 2. Remove the hose and valve assembly.
- 3. Retain the hose clamps.
- 4. Sterndrive and in-line inboard models only: cut 425 mm (16.75 in.) from a new vent valve assembly hose length from poppet valve end to vent valve.
- 5. Inboard V-Drive models: hose is to proper length.
- 6. Install the retained hose clamps over each end of the vent valve hose assembly.
- 7. Install the hose ends to the bottom side of the exhaust elbow and poppet valve.
- 8. Tighten the hose clamps to the specified torque.
- 9. Supply water to the engine to start and run while checking for leaks.
