Force Model Numbering System

This bulletin was prepared to help you understand the Force model numbering system. The model number provides the following information:

- Horsepower
- Driveshaft Length/Transom Height (Even Number - 20" Shaft) (Odd Number - 25" Shaft)
- 3. Brand
- 4. Model Year
- 5. Production Variant

EXAMPLE:



- 1. 120 = 120 Horsepower
- 2. 8 = 20 Inch Driveshaft/Transom Height
- 3. X = Bayliner, A = Maxum, F = Force
- 4. 90 = 1990 Model Year Engine, 9 = 1989, 8 = 1988, etc.
- 5. B = Second Production Variant

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
