Oil Thermostat/Filter Adapter Power Steering Interference

Situation

In certain cases MerCruiser engines below the following listed S/Ns and equipped with the Oil Thermostat/Filter Adapter and Dual Cable Power Steering may experience interference by the end of the power steering unit coming in contact with the side of the oil thermostat/filter causing a lack of full steering range.


Correction

A new Mounting plate Part Number 848556-2, will move the Adapter Block/filter approx. 3/8" outboard and allow the required steering travel. Order new Oil Thermostat/Filter Adapter Mounting Plate, if your engine is at or below the listed serial number break, and this interference exists.

500 Bulldog	OF745069
525SC	OF745118

Engines above these S/Ns will come equipped with the new mounting plate.

Labor of 1.0 hr. is allowed for warranty replacement of this mounting plate.



- a Oil Thermostat/Filter Mounting Plate
- b Mounting Plate Attaching Bolts
- c Engine Cooler
- d Cooler Mounting Bolts
- e Move approx. 3/8" toward filter
- 1. Remove the Oil Thermostat/Filter mounting plate attaching bolts and lock washers from the engine. Retain bolts and lock washers for reassembly.
- 2. Remove the two mounting plate attaching bolts and lock washers fastening the mounting plate to the rear of the filter adaptor block. Retain bolts and lock washers for reassembly.
- 3. Loosen the engine cooler mounting bolts and slide the cooler toward the Oil Thermostat/Filter 3/8" (38 mm). Do not re-tighten cooler mounting bolts at this time
- 4. Install the new mounting plate to the back of the Oil thermostat/Filter Adaptor with the bolts and lock washers retained at removal. Tighten securely.
- 5. Install the mounting plate to the engine block and secure with the bolts and lock washers retained at removal. Tighten securely.
- 6. Tighten the engine cooler mounting bolts securely.
