

This service bulletin refers to the yellow MerCathode controller with the LED light, and part number 8M0079687. The controller is installed on all M-Series and NXT ECP transoms, starting with serial number 0M969292.




This controller produces electrical current that flows into the water to protect the propulsion system from corrosion. While this current will not cause injury, it may be felt by a diver/swimmer in close proximity to the MerCathode anode.



NOTE: In order to alleviate any concerns this electric field may cause, **it is recommended to disconnect power to the MerCathode controller while divers/swimmers are within 1 m (3 ft) of the anode**. Power can be disconnected by either removing the fuse (contained in the controller wire harness), or by opening a circuit breaker on the controller power circuit. If power cannot be disconnected, stay 1 m (3 ft) away from the MerCathode anode, and recommend the diver wear full finger diving gloves.
